In 1995 Rupert secured a placement to Raymond Blanc's Manoir au Quat' Saison in Oxford, and proved such a success that Raymond asked him to stay on, which he did until 1997. His next strategic career move took him to work for the infamous John Burton Race, at the 2 Michelin starred L'Ortolan restaurant in Reading. In 2001, Rupert decided to brave the kitchens of Gordon Ramsay at his flagship eponymous 3 Michelin starred Chelsea restaurant. Returning to his roots, Rupert joined Fischer's Baslow Hall as Sous Chef in 2002, and was appointed Head Chef in 2003. Since then, Rupert has been crucial in Fischer's holding a Michelin star for 22 continuous years.
